1846 – 47

John Mason, house, sign and ornamental painter, 1 Broad Street, home 68 Main Street

1847 – 48

John Mason of J.M. & Co., home 68 Main Street.

J. Mason & Co., bottlers and dealers in ale, porter, and mineral waters, and manufacturers of root & lemon beer, home 14 Broad Street.

1848 – 49

First year Bottler listed at 62 Broad Street, John Lamppin, manufacturer of root & lemon beer and mineral water and porter, 62 Broad Street, home same.

1849 – 50

Same as 1848 – 49

1850 - 51

Same as 1848 – 49

1853 – 54

J. H. Lamppin & Co., 62 Broad Street

1854 – 55, no Lamppin

A. L. Edic, manufacturer of porter & ale, 62 Broad Street, boards same

1855 – 56

A. L. Edic, manufacturer of summer beverages, 62 Broad Street, residence same

1856 – 57

No Edic, no Lamppin (Who lived at 62 Broad Street?)

1857 – 58

No Edic, no Lamppin

1859 60

No Edic, no Lamppin

1861 – 62

No Edic, no Lamppin, no Lord listed

1862 – 63

No Edic, no Lamppin, no Lord listed

1863 – 64

No Avery Lord listed

1864 – 65

Avery Lord, soda manufacturer, residence, office 62 Broad Street (first listing)

1866 – 67

A.N. Lord, soda manufacturer, residence, office 62 Broad Street. (First listing for Charles Lord, laborer, 16 Post Street) Charles was Avery N. Lord's son.

1867 – 68

A.N. Lord, residence, office 62 Broad Street. (No Charles Lord listed)

1900

Avery N. Lord, 66 Broad Street

1901

Charles Lord listed as agent, but does not state for who, his residence is listed as 51 Second Street.

1902

Charles Lord listed as agent again, but does not state for who, his residence is listed as 51 Second Street, no Sciortino or Schaub listed for Broad Street under Bottlers, however Fred Schaub was listed as a Hostler, home 21 Broad Street

1903 – August 1904

Charles N. Lord, 68 Broad Street, listed under Bottlers

1904

Charles N. Lord, 68 Broad Street, listed under Bottlers

1905

Fred B. Schaub, 66 – 68 Broad Street, listed under Bottlers

1915

Fred B. Schaub, 502 Broad Street

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Fred B. Schaub, 502 Broad Street (the U.S. Postal Service changed the house numbers in Utica, what was 66 Broad Street was now 502 Broad Street.

1918

Fred B. Schaub, 502 Broad Street (no Scioritino listing at all, residence or business)

1919

Joseph Sciortino, 502 Broad Street (name was spelled Sciartino in listing, which was wrong)

1920

Joseph Sciortino, 502 Broad Street

1921, 1922 or 1923, no Utica Directories at Oneida County Historical Society (gone to have new bindings)

1924

Utica Bottling Works, 502 Broad Street

1925

Utica Bottling Works, 502 Broad Street

1928

Utica Bottling Works, 502 Broad Street

1930

Utica Bottling Works, 502 Broad Street, no listing at all for Anthony Flint or Fred Schaub.

1931

Anthony Flint, of Flints Bottling Works, but no address for business. No listing under Bottlers for 502 Broad Street

1932

Last year a Bottler was listed at the Broad Street addresses (formerly 62, 66 or 68 Broad Street), Flints Utica Bottling Works, 502 Broad Street under Bottlers, Anthony Flint of Flints Bottling Works, residence 751 Mary Street, doesn't list business address.

1935

Flints Bottling Works now at 709 Mary Street

1937

Flints Bottling Works, 709 Mary Street, listed under Bottlers.

1938, 1939, 1940 and 1941, no listings for 502 Broad Street under Bottlers.
